Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Board of Education has approved a schedule which would allow for delayed openings or early dismissals in cases of extremely inclement weather or other emergency situations. Notification of such changes in the school day will be broadcast on radio stations WCTC-AM 1450 or WMGQ (98.3 FM) on your radio dial whenever possible or on the district website, www.sayrevillek12.net.

In case of a sudden emergency, it may be necessary to send children home earlier than the stated time. Please be aware of this possibility and have necessary provisions made for your child's early return from school.

We appreciate your cooperation in insuring the welfare and safety of your child.

The schedules for delayed opening and early dismissals are as follows:

I would also like to remind you that you should call the attendance tape at 525-5291 any day school is in session and your child is absent. You are also required to provide a note to your child's homeroom teacher upon his/her return to school explaining the reason for the absence. The note is required by school policy and must be sent even though you called the attendance tape.
